John 3:16-18

(18) He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Acts 4:12 KJV


Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

1Corinthians 15:3-4

(3) For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;

(4) And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

1Peter 2:22,24 (22) Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: (24) Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree...

2 Corinthians 5:21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.



How can you be saved?

Acts 16:30-31

(30) And brought them out, and said,

Sirs, what must I do to be saved?

(31) And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ,
and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

John 6:47

Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me
hath everlasting life.

What Will Not Save You?

Galatians 2:16 Knowing that a man is **not justified by the works of the law**, but by the **faith** of Jesus Christ, even we have **believed** in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the **faith** of Christ, and **not by the works** of the law: for by the **works of the law** shall no flesh be justified.

Titus 3:5 **Not by works of righteousness which we have done**, but according to his mercy he saved us...

Romans 4:5 But to him that **worketh not**, but **believeth** on him that justifieth the ungodly, **his faith** is counted for righteousness.

Romans 11:6 And if **by grace**, then **is it no more of works**: otherwise grace is no more grace.

But **if it be of works**, then **is it no more grace**: otherwise work is no more work.

Ephesians 2:8-9 (8) For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that **not of yourselves**: it is the gift of God:
(9) Not of works, lest any man should boast.

What If I Sin After I've Been Saved?


John 3:3 Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

JESUS IS GOD!



John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God.** (2) The same was in the beginning with God. (3) **All things were made by him;** and without him was not any thing made that was made. (14) **And the Word was made flesh,** and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. (KJV)

Philippians 2:5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: (6) Who, **being in the form of God,** thought it not robbery to be **equal with God:** (9) Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and **given him a name which is above every name:** (10) **That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,** of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth; (11) And *that* every tongue should confess that **Jesus Christ is Lord,** to the glory of God the Father. (KJV)

Hebrews 1:8 **But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God,** is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness *is* the sceptre of thy kingdom. (KJV)

Titus 2:13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of **the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;**

1 John 5:20 And we know that the **Son of God is come,** and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, *even* in his Son Jesus Christ. **This is the true God, and eternal life.** (KJV)

Do I Have to Repent of Sins to be Saved?

Jonah 3:10 And God saw their **works**, that they **turned from their evil way**; and God repented of the evil, that he had said that he would do unto them; and he did *it* not.

Acts 17:29-30 (29) Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, **we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device.** **idols*

(30) And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but **now commandeth all men every where to repent:**

Repentance is turning from a false belief, to trusting in Christ alone!

Mark 1:15 ...**Repent** ye, and **believe** the gospel.

Acts 19:4 Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of **repentance**, saying unto the people, that they **should believe** on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus.

Acts 20:21 Testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, **repentance** toward God, and **faith** toward our Lord Jesus Christ.

Do I Have to Repent of Sins to be Saved?

The Rich in hell asked for Lazarus to be sent back to warn his brothers about hell.

Luke 16:23-31

(27) Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house:

(28) For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment.

(29) Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.

(30) And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent.

(31) And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.

YOU CANNOT MIX WORKS AND GRACE!

Romans 11:6

And if by grace, then is it no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work.

Romans 4:1-8 KJV

- (1) What shall we say then that Abraham our father, as pertaining to the flesh, hath found?
- (2) For if Abraham were justified by works, he hath *whereof* to glory; but not before God.
- (3) For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.
- (4) Now to him that worketh is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt.
- (5) But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.
- (6) Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works,
- (7) *Saying*, Blessed *are* they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered.
- (8) Blessed *is* the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin.

Revelation 20:11-15

(11) And I saw **a great white throne**, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

(12) And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is **the book of life**: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

(13) And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and **they were judged every man according to their works.**

(14) And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the **second death.**

(15) And whosoever was not found written in **the book of life** was cast into **the lake of fire.**
